

Most supplements are bound with the issues of the corresponding volume or year, particularly if they:

- are issued as a full or partial number of a periodical;
- are itemized in the table of contents or index;
- appear as an item in the online version of the periodical.

Supplements should be arranged and bound in accordance with the following:

- If a supplement is published as a numbered issue, or as part of a numbered issue, bind it where it appears:
  - Supplement numbered as issue no.5 - bind as issue no.5.
- If a supplement is part of an issue, but separately published, bind it after the issue
  - Part II of no.3 - bind immediately after Part I of no.3
  - Supplement to the August issue - bind immediately after the August issue.
  - Supplement to issue no.6 - bind immediately after no.6.
- If a supplement is separately published but not related to a particular issue, bind it at the end of the volume
  - Unnumbered supplement to v.12 - bind after all the numbered issues.
